Janus Center for Youth in Crisis

This is a program of the Council of Churches of Greater Bridgeport to assist young people ages 11-17. The program provides intervention services for youth and their families to deescalate the crisis, reunite families, keep the youth in school and out of the juvenile justice system. Social workers have regular office hours in eight public schools in Bridgeport and Stratford, and work with the faculty to identify students in need of intervention. They provide a 24-hour youth in crisis hotline, counseling, and referrals to necessary services. The Janus Center has host families to provide short-term respite care for youth who cannot return home immediately and aren't under state care. The staff consists of two social workers and is supplemented with interns from the social work programs of local universities.
